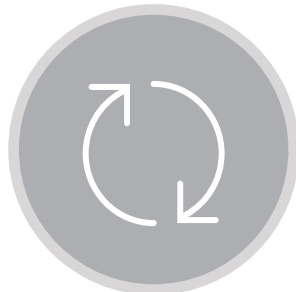

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS
