A registered nurse is responsible for providing patient care, monitoring vital signs, and administering medications. They also provide emotional support and education to patients and their families.

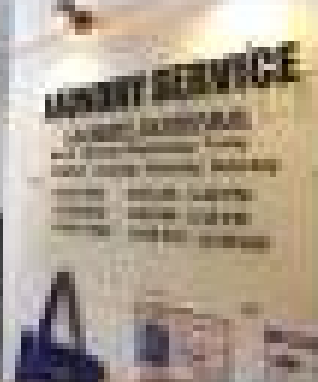
## Housekeeper
